

5th International Workshop on Level Density and Gamma Strength Oslo, May 18-22, 2015

The Department of Physics at the University of Oslo will host an International Workshop on Level Density and Gamma Strength in Oslo, May 18-22, 2015. The workshop is the fifth in a series of biannual meetings in Oslo devoted to the subject. The 17th of May is the Norwegian national day, so this year instead of a reception on Sunday, it is moved to the evening of Monday, May 18. The scientific program will start in the morning of Monday, May 18, and finish in the afternoon of Friday, May 22. Scientific Program

The scientific program will include invited talks, selected oral contributions from submitted abstracts, and poster presentations, covering the following topics:

- Nuclear level density
- Gamma-strength function
- Phase transitions in mesoscopic systems
- Applications in astrophysics and reactor physics
- Other related topics

As in previous Oslo Workshops, the program will allow ample time for discussions. On Friday there will be a discussion session on how to proceed with a gamma strength database to be managed by IAEA. The list of speakers and a detailed program will be posted on the conference website.

Call for abstracts

Contributions are welcome and those who wish to contribute are kindly requested to submit a short abstract **no later than March 1, 2015**. The abstract should be in PDF format, no longer than one page, and be sent by e-mail to workshop2015@fys.uio.no. Oral contributions will be selected with the help of the International Advisory Committee. The selected speakers will be notified before March 15. Participants will also have the opportunity to present their work during a poster session. All participants will receive a book of abstracts.
